Creator of the world

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin promises joy at first then fails later

#2. Healing the royal official’s son

John 4:43-54

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Power over distance

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin brings anxiety to households

#3. Healing the Capernaum demoniac

Mark 1:21-27 Luke 4:31-36

Revelation of Christ’s glory

God at work and Satan opposing and defeated

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin is rebellion and opposition to God

#4. Healing Peter’s mother-in-law

Matthew 8:14-15 Mark 1:29-31 Luke 4:38-39

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Ability to restore to full health and service

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin brings restlessness in the flesh and feverishness to our lives

#5. Healing the sick during the evening

Matthew 8:16-17 Mark 1:32-34 Luke 4:40-41

Revelation of Christ’s glory

He took our infirmities

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin attacks us in every phase and form

#6. Catching a large number of fish

Luke 5:1-11

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Overwhelming display of His power

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin gives lack of productivity and brings fruitlessness

#7. Healing a leper

Matthew 8:1-4 Mark 1:40-45 Luke 5:12-14

Revelation of Christ’s glory

God answers prayer

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin brings loathsome defilement and separation

#8. Healing the centurion’s servant

Matthew 8:23-27 Mark 4:38-41 Luke 8:22-25

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ is for the nations

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin brings paralysis

#9. Healing a paralyzed man

Matthew 9:1-8 Mark 2:1-12 Luke 5:17-26

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Energy given to those who are weak

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin makes us unable to do God’s will

#10. Healing a withered hand

Matthew 12:9-13 Mark 3:1-6 Luke 6:6-11

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Power of Christ given to serve

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Uselessness caused by sin

#11. Raising a widow’s son

Luke 7:11-17

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ has power over death

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin brings sadness and separation

#12. Jesus calms a storm on the sea

Matthew 8:23-27 Mark 4:38-41 Luke 8:22-25

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ has power over the upheavals of life

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin brings fear encourages lack of faith and uses many weapons to try to defeat the work of God

#13. Jesus casts out demons into swine

Matthew 8:28-33 Mark 5:1-20 Luke 8:26-39

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ has Power over Satan and can raise up witness for himself in dark places

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin causes misery, violence, and terror

14. Jesus heals a woman with an issue of blood

Matthew 9:20-22 Mark 5:25-34 Luke 8:42-48

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ can remove the weakness was caused by sin

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin has the power to sap life and its vitality

15. Jesus raises Jairus’ daughter back to life

Matthew 9:18 Matthew 9:23-26 Mark 5:21-24 Mark 5:35-43 Luke 8:40-42 Luke 8:49-56

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ cares for children, knows their needs and can meet their needs.

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Spiritual death is caused by sin

Summary of “Glory” and “Sin” themes in Jesus’ miracles

16. Jesus heals two blind men

Matthew 9:27-31

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ gives the good news which can illuminate the heart, head and soul.

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin brings no mercy to its captives and keeps them in darkness

17. Jesus heals a man who was unable to speak

Matthew 9:32-34

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ can awaken any man under the control of Satan to be free to praise him

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin keeps us from expressing our heart and words to God

18. Jesus heals an invalid

John 5:1-15

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ can break the long-standing control and the power of sin in a moment

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin keeps its captives in a false hope of deliverance

19. Jesus feeds 5000 plus women and children

Matthew 14:13-21

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ came to meet the need of a hungry world and provide sustenance as the Bread of Life

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin keeps people in bondage, hunger, and in need

20. Jesus walks on water

Matthew 14:22-33

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ’s Divine law dominates natural law – His guidance vouchsafed

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin can turn nature against us in its power. Sin keeps us from understanding God’s word.

Summary of “Glory” and “Sin” themes in Jesus’ miracles

21. Jesus heals many sick in Gennesaret as they touch his garment

Matthew 14:34-36 Mark 6:53-56

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ is the one who can bring hope to all who look for him

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin and its effects are widespread and relentless

22. Jesus heals a Gentile woman’s demon possessed daughter

Matthew 15:21-28 Mark 7:24-30

Revelation of Christ’s glory

He is the Christ for the nations

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin will never give the best to those in its captivity, causes hopelessness and helplessness

23. Jesus heals a deaf and dumb man

Mark 7:31-37

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ can awaken a man to become a witness for Christ

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin causes an inability to hear God’s word and speak of spiritual things

24. Jesus feeds 4000 plus women and children

Matthew 15:32-39 Mark 8:1-13

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ can bring satisfaction to the hungry soul

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin brings emptiness, hunger, and need to the world

25. Jesus heals a blind man at Bethesda

Mark 8:22-26

Revelation of Christ’s glory

He can illuminate the darkened soul with the good news of the Gospel

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin brings bondage, darkness, and inability to see things according to truth

Summary of “Glory” and “Sin” themes in Jesus’ miracles

26. Jesus heals a man born blind

John 9:1-12

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ can give sight to the blind and hope

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Man’s religion cannot solve spiritual blindness and hates the One who can heal it

27. Jesus heals a boy with an unclean spirit

Matthew 17:14-20 Mark 9:14-29

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ has compassion and has the victory over sin and Satan

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin brings cruelty and thralldom on his victims.

28. Miraculous temple tax in a fish mouth

Matthew 17:24-27

Revelation of Christ’s glory

He is in control of timing and details of life’s events

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin Keeps us from recognizing the greatness of the person of Christ

29. Jesus heals a blind mute demoniac

Matthew 12:22-23 Luke 11:14-23

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ is greater than Beelzebub or any power of Hell

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin causes dumbness and giving no ability to experience and testify of God’s greatness

30. Jesus heals a woman who had been crippled of 18 years

Luke 13:10-17

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ is able to straighten out what sin has twisted and set the prisoner free

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin keeps us bent down in defeat making us unable to see his glory

Summary of “Glory” and “Sin” themes in Jesus’ miracles

31. Jesus heals a man with dropsy on the Sabbath

Luke 14:1-6

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ is greater than man’s religious systems

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin has no compassion and causes men to not be valued and viewed as made in the image of God

32. Jesus cleanses ten lepers on His way to Jerusalem

Luke 17:11-19

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ deserves thanks and honor for his salvation - Necessity of thankfulness heart

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin causes us to have an unthankful proud attitude

33. Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead at Bethany

John 11:1-45

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ Conquered death and gives life to those dead in trespasses and sins

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin brings death and sadness to the world

34. Jesus restores sight to Bartimaeus at Jericho

Matthew 20:29-34 Mark 10:46-52 Luke 18:35-43

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ brings joy and understanding to men who believe

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin reduces mankind to blind and beggarly state

35. Jesus withers the fig tree on the road from Bethany

Matthew 21:18-22 Mark 11:12-14

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ deserves glory and honor and a full heart

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin in its persistency brings unfruitfulness and hypocrisy

Summary of “Glory” and “Sin” themes in Jesus’ miracles

36. Jesus heals a servant’s severed ear while he is being arrested

Luke 22:50-51

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ humbled himself to death on the cross

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin has caused rulers and religion to be against Christ

37. The second miraculous catch of fish at the sea of Tiberias

John 21:4-11

Revelation of Christ’s glory

Christ is the resurrected, real, glorified man in heaven

Illustration of Sin and its effect:

Sin encourages unbelief and disappointment
